

## Bible Qualities women should have



Below is a list of qualities the Bible talks about for virtuous and attractive women. It is by no means a final list.

Go through the list and rate yourself on a scale of 1 – 10. For example if you think you are a very kind person (or if people have told you that you are kind) then you may give yourself a score of 8 or 9. If you think that you are not a very good business woman then you may score yourself as

3 or 4.

You are not to go about starting to work on the areas that you are weak. In fact I want you to ignore them for now. What I want you to do is to take your strengths and really begin to display them to the world. For example if you are a very good helper then begin to use this skill to help in the men ministries at church. Help them organize functions and activities. If you have a great sense of humour share it by amusing people and being the life of the party.

You owe it to the world not to bury your treasure but to contribute to everyone you come in contact with. Guess what, people will begin to talk about you and your reputation will attract the right type of person to you.

<b>Not quarrelsome or cantankerous</b>	A <b>quarrelsome</b> wife is like a constant dripping <a href="#">Prov. 19:13</a> .  Better to live on a corner of the roof than to share a house with a <b>quarrelsome</b> wife. <a href="#">Prov. 21:9</a>  Better to live in a desert than with a <b>quarrelsome</b> and ill-tempered wife. <a href="#">Prov. 21:19</a>	
<b>Graceful</b>	A <b>gracious</b> woman attains honour, And violent men attain riches ( <a href="#">Prov.11:16</a> ).	
<b>Kind-hearted</b>	A <b>kind-hearted</b> woman gains respect, but ruthless men gain only wealth <a href="#">Prov. 11:16</a>  She extends a <b>helping hand</b> to the poor and opens her arms to the needy. <a href="#">Prov. 31:20</a>	
<b>Industrious</b>	She finds wool and flax and busily spins it. <a href="#">Prov. 31:13</a>	
<b>Helper</b>	She will not hinder him but help him all her life. <a href="#">Prov. 31:12</a>	
<b>Worthy</b>	A <b>worthy</b> wife is her husband's joy and crown; a shameful wife saps his strength <a href="#">Prov. 12:4</a>	
<b>Virtuous</b>	Who can find a <b>virtuous</b> and capable wife? She is worth more than precious rubies. <a href="#">Prov. 31:10</a>  A <b>virtuous</b> woman <i>is</i> a crown to her husband: but she that maketh ashamed <i>is</i> as rottenness in his bones ( <a href="#">Pro 12:4</a> ).	
<b>Bargain hunter</b>	She watches for <b>bargains</b> ; her lights burn late into the night <a href="#">Prov. 31:18</a>	
<b>Home maker</b>	She gets up before dawn to <b>prepare breakfast</b> for her household and plan the day's work for her servant girls...  She quilts her own bedspreads. She dresses like royalty in gowns of finest cloth. <a href="#">Prov. 31:22</a>	
<b>Good deeds</b>	In like manner also, that women adorn themselves ...with <b>good works</b> . ( <a href="#">1Ti 2:9,10</a> )	
<b>Wise and well spoken</b>	She opens her mouth in <b>wisdom</b> , And the teaching of <b>kindness</b> is on her tongue ( <a href="#">Prov. 31:26</a> ).	

<b>Fears the lord</b>	Charm is deceptive, and beauty does not last; but a woman who <b>fears</b> the Lord will be greatly praised. <a href="#">Prov. 31:30</a>	
<b>Noble</b>	A wife of <b>noble</b> character is her husband's crown, but a disgraceful wife is like decay in his bones.	
<b>Gentle and quiet spirit</b>	You should be known for the beauty that comes from within, the unfading beauty of a <b>gentle</b> and <b>quiet</b> spirit, which is so precious to God. <a href="#">1Peter 3:3</a>	
<b>Business woman/hard worker</b>	She goes out to inspect a field and <b>buys</b> it; with her earnings she plants a vineyard, hard worker. She is energetic and strong, a hard worker <a href="#">Prov. 31:16,17</a>  She makes belted linen garments and sashes to <b>sell</b> to the merchants. <a href="#">Prov. 31:24</a>	
<b>Have a sense of humour</b>	..... She <b>laughs</b> with no fear of the future. <a href="#">Prov. 31:25</a>
